Looking for ideas for more summer learning fun? Here are a few things to try...

Summer activity ideas:

1. Create **ART** inspired by a book you read and explain how your art relates to the book.
2. Create a **BOARD GAME** inspired by a book you read and write instructions for how to play.
3. Write a **PLAY** based on a book you read (or your favorite part of the story).
4. Develop a **COMIC STRIP** based on a book you read.
5. Write a **BOOK REVIEW** of a book you read.
6. **RESEARCH** the author or a person, place or thing that is part of a book you read and write a report on what you learned.
7. **BOOK CLUB** - Reach out to Selwyn friends and choose a book to read together and discuss.
8. Write a **LETTER** to a friend from Selwyn or an out-of-town friend or relative – everyone loves to get mail and you could become pen pals!

Explore the theme of **MAGIC**:

1. **HOW-TO** – Check out a book that teaches magic tricks for kids.
2. **MATH MAGIC** – Try out these cool math magic tricks!
